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MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS

FOR DIRECT ANTERIOR TOTAL HIP ARTHROPLASTY

65 Years and Under

FIRST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SURGERY:

- Celebrex® 200 mg twice daily with food to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
- OxyContin® 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
- Lyrica® 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.

POST-OP MEDICATION REGIMEN:

- Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food. Take the medication until the prescription is completed.
- Tylenol® 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter Tylenol 500 mg tablets.
- Aspirin 81 mg to be taken twice daily for a total of 6 weeks for DVT prophylaxis.
- Dilaudid® 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain. 20 pills total.
- Lyrica 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm until the prescription is completed.
