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## MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DIRECT ANTERIOR TOTAL HIP ARTHROPLASTY

65 Years and Under

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☐ Celebrex® 200 mg twice daily with food to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
☐ OxyContin® 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
$\hfill\Box$ Lyrica® 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
OST-OP MEDICATION REGIMEN:
$\square$ Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food. Take the medication until the prescription is completed.
☐ Tylenol® 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter Tylenol 500 mg tablets.
$\square$ Aspirin 81 mg to be taken twice daily for a total of 6 weeks for DVT prophylaxis.
☐ Dilaudid® 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain. 20 pills total.
☐ Lyrica 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm until the prescription is completed.
