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## **MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS** FOR DIRECT ANTERIOR TOTAL HIP ARTHROPLASTY

Cardiac Issues, Sulfa Allergy • 65 Years and Under

## **FIRST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SURGERY:**

- $\hfill\square$  Mobic® 15 mg once daily with food to be taken at 8:00 am.
- $\hfill\square$  OxyContin® 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
- $\hfill\square$  Lyrica  $^{\ensuremath{\oplus}}$  50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.

## **POST-OP MEDICATION REGIMEN:**

- $\Box$  Mobic 15 mg to be taken once daily with food until prescription is completed.
- □ Tylenol<sup>®</sup> 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter Tylenol 500 mg tablets.
- □ Aspirin 81 mg to be taken twice daily for a total of 6 weeks for DVT prophylaxis.
- Dilaudid<sup>®</sup> 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain. 20 pills total.
- $\Box$  Lyrica 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm until the prescription is completed.
