High Risk DVT • 65 Years and Over

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 □ Celebrex® 200 mg twice daily with food to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm. □ OxyContin® 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
POST-OP MEDICATION REGIMEN:
☐ Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food for a total of 2 weeks until prescription is completed.
☐ Tylenol® 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter Tylenol 500 mg tablets.
☐ Lovenox® 40 mg subcutaneous injection once daily for a total of 4 weeks for DVT prophylaxis.
☐ Dilaudid® 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain, 20 pills total
