MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DIRECT ANTERIOR TOTAL HIP ARTHROPLASTY

High Risk DVT, Cardiac Issues, Sufa Allergy • 65 Years and Under

FIRST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SURGERY:

- $\hfill\square$ Mobic® 15 mg once daily with food to be taken at 8:00 am.
- $\Box\,$ OxyContin[®] 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.
- $\hfill\square$ Lyrica $^{\ensuremath{ extsf{ iny boundary condition}}$ 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.

POST-OP MEDICATION REGIMEN:

- □ Mobic 15 mg to be taken once daily with food until prescription is completed.
- □ Tylenol[®] 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter Tylenol 500 mg tablets.
- Lovenox[®] 40 mg subcutaneous injection once daily for a total of 4 weeks for DVT prophylaxis.
- Dilaudid[®] 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain. 20 pills total.
- \Box Lyrica 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 am and 8:00 pm until the prescription is completed.
