Medication Instructions for Direct Anterior Total Hip <u>Arthroplasty</u>

FIRST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SURGERY:

- 1. Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food to be taken at 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- 2. OxyContin 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

POST OPERATIVE MEDICATION REGIMEN:

- 1. Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food for a total of 2 weeks until prescription is completed
- 2. Tylenol 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter 500 mg Tylenol tablets.
- 3. Aspirin 81 mg twice daily for a total of 6 weeks for DVT prophylaxis.
- 4. Dilaudid 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain with a total of 20 pills.
