## Medication Instructions for Direct Anterior Total Hip Arthroplasty

## **FIRST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SURGERY:**

- 1. Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food to be taken at 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- 2. OxyContin 10 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- 3. Lyrica 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

## **POST OPERATIVE MEDICATION REGIMEN:**

- 1. Celebrex 200 mg twice daily with food. Take the medication until the prescription is completed.
- 2. Tylenol 1000 mg to be taken 3 times daily for 1 week. Then can be take it as needed for pain. Patient needs to purchase over-the-counter 500 mg Tylenol tablets.
- 3. Aspirin 81 mg to be taken twice daily for a total of 6 weeks. For DVT prophylaxis.
- 4. Dilaudid 2 mg every 4 hours as needed for pain with a total of 20 pills.
- 5. Lyrica 50 mg twice daily to be taken at 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. until the prescription is completed.
